What draws us towards people is seeing things about them we like, respect or admire. They have qualities, characteristics, traits, a way of behaving, personality, morality or warmth that endears us to them.

The same applies to God!

When we like something or someone long enough that 'liking' turns into 'loving'.

Whenever we feel love for someone there are usually reasons as to why we have come to treasure them. The effect they have on us has become indispensable for specific reasons.

It can often require meditation or reflection on our part to highlight what it is about someone that causes our like of them to turn to love for them.

'1001 Reasons to Worship' as a piece of work is an aid to that very goal in relation to God. Reflections that inspire our various reasons for loving Him.

It is one thing to tell a loved one that we love them, but what if they ask why!

'Why do you love me? What is it about me you love?'.

This isn't an unreasonable question to be asked by a loved one and God has every right to ask that question too!

With most loved ones we have, it might be because of things about them, the way they do certain things for example, specific ways they treat us and so on that they have become dear to us and cause us to cherish them.

This should all so much more apply to our loving God!

However, how can we summarise God? How can we fully fathom His greatness? Can His worth to us begin to be measured? Can the blessings of knowing Him be counted. Where would a list of His attributes begin or end?

Clearly we have not actually therefore quantified the reasons into 1001 but use that figure as merely an illustration in our own minds of a large number.

Clearly there is an aspect in which His Love towards us is forever unfolding and that much of what we have Is based on how we find or have already experienced Him and His Love. We turn however to His own word again for continued inspiration and rely upon His own declarations of what He is to us.

God accepts and understands however that for our love for Him to be true and real we must appropriate and realise those declarations of who He is to us. Knowing them and seeing them as laid out in a list like this we pray will prove to be a valuable aid.

Then Satan answered the LORD, and said, Doth Job fear God for nought? (Isn't it because of all you've blessed him with, Satan goes on to say that he loves You?)

#### Job:1:9

'I love the LORD, because he hath heard my voice and my supplications', the Psalmist says in chapter 116 verse 1.

Here this psalmist gives a definite reason for why he loves the Lord.

Love of this specific kind existed between Jesus and a few of his disciples...

Then Peter, turning about, seeth the disciple whom Jesus loved following;

John:21:20

So when they had dined, Jesus saith to Simon Peter, Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me more than these? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my lambs.

John:21:15

'1001 Reasons To Worship' is a library of reasons, with verses that highlight his nature, his heart, character, attributes and qualities.

God understands that who or what we treasure in life will win our heart. He understands that we will have reasons for why we have come to treasure what or who it is we treasure.

'where our treasure is, there will our heart be also'.

#### Matthew:6:21

This is where God Almighty excels like no other. There is none other who comes close to comparing with how He is able to become treasure to the human heart. The things He does and the way He does those things are all designed by Him to woo and ultimately win our hearts with wonder. He is enchanting, inspiring, captivating in His ways and always acts out of love because that is what He is.

'1001 Reasons to Worship' is an ever evolving list of scriptures which tries to highlight what He is like and **why** He is worthy of our love.

As you use the following scripture 'library' of verses it is our prayer that His Holy Spirit will bring revelation to you of what He is like and that your love and worship for Him will receive inspiration.
